On 10-23-10 at approximately 0204 hours, Officer HAMPTON and I were in uniform, driving a marked police vehicle. We heard over the police radio Officer MILLER asking for additional police officers at Harbor and Amerige due to a large fight. Officer HAMPTON and I arrived at the location and saw a large fight in the 100 block of W. Amerige. We ran up to the location and saw Officer MILLER on the ground struggling with a subject, later identified as LENG. I saw LENG on top of Officer MILLER and he was attempting to strike Officer MILLER. Officer MILLER was attempting to apply a carotid control hold. LENG was told to stop resisting several times by Officer MILLER. A large crowd then began forming around us and I diverted my attention to the crowd and additional subjects that were fighting. For further information regarding LENG, refer to Officer MILLER'S supplemental report. LENG was arrested for assault on a police officer and resisting arrest.

While dispersing the subjects in the area, I came in contact with AGUILAR. AGUILAR had a strong odor of alcohol coming from his person and his speech was slurred, and he was having difficulty maintaining his balance. Due to the volital situation, I told AGUILAR to leave the area. I subsequently told him a total of four separate times. AGUILAR continued to stay in the area. Due to my observations of AGUILAR, I felt that he was a danger to himself and others. I arrested AGUILAR for drunk in public.

HAMPTON and I transported LENG and AGUILAR to the Fullerton City Jail. LENG was released to the jailer and charged with assault on a police officer and resisting arrest. AGUILER was released to the jailer and charged with drunk in public.

On 10-23-10 at about 0204 hours, I responded to a help call from Officer Miller, #1350. He advised he was in a fight and nothing more. Dispatch told responding Officers his location. I arrived at 100 W. Amerige and saw Officer Miller fighting several people. There was a very large crowd of about 100 people around the officers and their cars. This was extremely unsafe for the officers and the arrestees.

I began ordering people away from the officers location and ordering the people to leave the area. Many of the people would not leave the area and had to be told many times. Officers had to start pushing many of the people to move them. I pushed several unknown males and females from the street and sidewalk into the parking lots. At one point, I had told suspect Barajas to leave many times. I told him if he did not leave he would be arrested. He refused to leave and I took hold of him and brought him over to my car and handcuffed him.

He was booked for violation of 148(a)(1) PC for refusing my orders to leave the area.

As Officer J. MILLER was trying to take LENG into custody, I saw a male subject from the crowd, identified as Veth MAM, jump on Officer MILLER's back. I saw MAM wrap his hands around Officer J. MILLER's neck and tried to choke him. I believed that MAM was trying to prevent Officer J. MILLER from taking his friend (LENG) into custody. I ran up to Officer J. MILLER to assist him and pulled MAM off of his back. I pushed MAM away from Officer J. MILLER and told him to get back. MAM was belligerent and continued approaching us.

The crowd became more unruly and we requested all units to respond to our location to assist. I kept the subjects from the unruly crowd away from Officer J. MILLER as he was wrestling with LENG until additional units arrived.

LENG and MAM were subsequently taken into custody, as well as other subjects from the crowd. For details, refer to the Corporal CONTINO and Officer HAMPTON's original report.

This contact was recorded on my DAR.







Upon arrival, A large unruly crowd was forming and they needed to be dispersed.

I asked Khorn Leng several times to go away. He was yelling "fuck that" and refusing to leave. His eyes were bloodshot and watery, and he had a smell of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. He was stumbling backwards as he was yelling. I told him again and he refused to leave, and instead was being pulled away by a friend.

He continued to be escorted by his friend to walk away, but he was intoxicated and not cooperating with his friend. I asked him again to leave and I put my arm up to prevent him from walking back towards the scene where an officer had been assaulted.

When I put my arm up, he used his right arm to push my arm away.

Based on his objective signs and symptoms and his behavior, I believed he was unable to care for his own safety and the safety of others.

I grabbed his right arm and he immediately tensed up his muscles. In fear he would flee or assault me, I pushed him against a wall and held his arm behind his back. Officer Song grabbed his other arm.

During the arrest, Officer Song injured his knee. He advised a supervisor on scene.

On 10-23-10 at approximately 0204 hours, Corporal CONTINO responded to the area of Harbor and AMERIGE to assist Officer MILLER with a disturbance. Upon our arrival, I observed Officer Miller involved in a fight with a male subject. The male subject was later identified as Sokha LENG. LENG was subsequently taken into custody with the assistance of several Fullerton Officers. For further, see Corporal CONTINO'S original report and Officer MILLER'S supplemental report.

Corporal CONTINO and I transported LENG to Fullerton Jail without any further incident.

I advised LENG of his Miranda Rights per my department issued Miranda Card. LENG replied, "Yes sir" to understanding all of his rights and told me the following. LENG said, "It was my fault." LENG said he was driving east on Amerige towards Harbor. LENG said he conducted a u-turn to look for his friends. LENG said while he was traveling west on Amerige a police vehicle pulled in front of his vehicle. LENG said he knew he was a police Officer because of the vehicle overhead lights.

LENG said at some point he was asked to exit the vehicle and place his hands behind his back. LENG said he did not know why he was being placed under arrest and why the Officer was very aggressive. LENG said he remembers the Officer telling him to relax. LENG said the Officer randomly began choking him and they fell to the ground. LENG said while they were on the ground, he felt somebody punching him in the left side of his head. LENG said he does not remember much after being on the ground. This concluded our interview.

During my interview with LENG, I was informed by LENG that he was the driver of a motor vehicle. During the course my interview with LENG, I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his person. LENG eyes were red, blood shot and watery and his speech was slightly slurred. LENG said he consumed several mixed beverages in downtown Fullerton.

With the assistance of Corporal CONTINO, I conducted several field coordination test in the Fullerton Jail sally port. While LENG was performing the Internal Clock Test, he estimated 60 seconds as 30 seconds. While performing the Walk and Turn Test, LENG took nine steps forward and ten steps backwards, not instructed. For further, see attached 502 form. Based on the objective signs of intoxication, the performance of the field coordination test, and LENG'S statement, I formed the opinion that LENG was intoxicated and unable to safely operate a motor vehicle. The charge of 23152(a)CVC was added.

I advised LENG of the Chemical Test Admonishment. LENG said he understood and would submit to a breath test. While at the Fullerton Jail, LENG provided two breath samples, both measuring .05 BAC. (Test#1361-#1362) Corporal CONTINO operated the breath machine.

On the above date and time I was working uniform patrol in a marked white and black police car. I was parked at 100 West Amerige in the parking lot facing northbound. I noticed a large group gathering in the north south alley where Ziings Bar lets out.

I noticed two male Asians in a verbal argument, the subjects started pushing each other. I started driving over to the subjects and noticed a silver suburban traveling westbound on Amerige at a very high rate of speed. The vehicle came to a skidding stop almost hitting my police vehicle, the suburban stopped approximately three feet from my front bumper. The driver, who was later identified as Sokha Leng, exited the driver side vehicle. At that time I was out of my car and was approaching the Suburban as Leng was walking toward me. I was in a well lighted area in visible police uniform. I asked Leng where he was going and he said, "To back up my friend who was going to get in a fight." I could smell a strong odor of alcohol emitting from LENG's person. I believed that Leng was operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. I asked Leng if he was on probation or parole and he did not reply. Leng ignored me and tried to walk around me to get involved with the fight that was on going with his friends. I grabbed both of Leng's arms and placed them behind his back in order to gain control of him and keep him from fighting. Leng turned and attempted to punch me with his right fist. I restrained Leng by placing him onto my police car and I radioed for units to assist. Another male subject came up from behind me and grabbed me, attempting to pull me off of Leng. The subject was later identified as Veth Mam. Leng was still resisting and attempting to punch me, so I pulled Leng down to the ground on his back. I told him to stop resisting and attempted to roll him over on his stomach to handcuff him. Leng kept hitting me and would not stop resisting. While I was on top of Leng, Mam came up from behind me and grabbed me around the neck in an attempt to strangle me.

I stood up and pushed Mam away from me and when I turned back around to where Leng was, he was already standing up. I grabbed Leng and turned him around and tried placing him in a carotid restraint, at that time Officer Nguyen arrived. Mam was grabbing me from my back again attempting to pull me off of Leng, Officer Nguyen grabbed Mam and pulled him off of me. Using a leg sweep. I took Leng to the ground. Several officers arrived and assisted me in taking Leng into custody. Officer Nguyen arrested Mam. Leng never lost consciousness as a result of the carotid restraint.

When I leg swept Leng, taking him to the ground I landed on my right elbow with all my weight and Leng's weight.

Sergeant Diaz and Lieutenant Crum arrived on scene and I told them about the situation. I told Sergeant Diaz while trying to take Leng into custody I injured my right elbow and forearm and was unable to make a fist. Officer Nguyen transported me to the St. Jude medical Center emergency room. While at the emergency room I had several x-rays taken and the examination did not reveal any breaks or fractures.
