14 The Orange County District Attorney charges that in Orange  
15 County, California, the law was violated as follows:

16 COUNT 1: On or about July 11, 2021, in violation of Section  
17 23152(a) of the Vehicle Code (DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF  
18 ALCOHOL), a MISDEMEANOR, ANTHONY DAVID VALLE did unlawfully  
19 drive a vehicle while under the influence of an alcoholic  
beverage.

20 COUNT 2: On or about July 11, 2021, in violation of Section  
21 23152(b) of the Vehicle Code (DRIVING WITH BLOOD ALCOHOL .08% OR  
22 MORE), a MISDEMEANOR, ANTHONY DAVID VALLE did unlawfully drive  
23 a vehicle while defendant's blood alcohol concentration was 0.08  
percent (%) or more by weight of alcohol in defendant's blood.

24 OTHER ALLEGATION(S)

25 As to Count(s) 2, it is further alleged pursuant to Vehicle Code  
26 section 23578 (BLOOD ALCOHOL .15 PERCENT), that defendant  
27 ANTHONY DAVID VALLE unlawfully had a concentration of alcohol in  
28 his/her blood of .15% and more by weight.
